WHAT DOES HENNA SIGNIFY?

"The Hebrew word for henna, kopher, means to cover. Figuratively, it means a redemptive price! The root word, kaphar, means to make atonement, cleanse, disannul, forgive, be merciful, pardon, to reconcile. Henna was used for dyeing and is red in color. It is easy to see the representation of the blood of Christ". Annette Ettinger

PRAY THESE PROCLAMATIONS AS YOU ANOINT WITH HENNA OIL:

- Satan is overcome by the Blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony, for I love God more than life itself! Hebr 13:12

HOW TO ANOINT with oil:

"Machag" in Hebrew means – to rub in with oil.

- First of all, allow the precious guidance of the Holy Spirit in every aspect of the anointing.
- The anointing of a person's hands represents the authority of the Holy Spirit in what a person does with his/her hands.
- The anointing of a person's feet represents his/her walk of faith.
- Anointing of the (fore)head can represent the blessing of God in every area. (Psalm 133)
