MYRRH ANOINTING OIL

Anointing for healing and preparation

As a Priest of God, I declare that this oil in my hand is separated unto God, for His purposes alone!

WHAT DOES MYRRH SIGNIFY?

Myrrh, also known as the most popular oil in Biblical times, means bitter. The Hebrew word mar, also Marar, refers to the bitter taste of the gum that oozes from the bark of the tree. Mary could have used the gift of Myrrh, given by the Wise men, as medicine, for she would have known its many healing properties. Esther was prepared for six months as part of her beauty treatment before becoming queen (Esther 2:12).

PRAY THESE PROCLAMATIONS AS YOU ANOINT WITH MYRRH OIL:

- As Myrrh is a bitter herb with a sweet smell, You O' Lord turn my bitter into sweet! - Romans 8:28
- Father, I pray for Your healing as I lay my hands on... (name of a person or oneself) - James 5:14,15
- I am in preparation for Your plan! - Jer 29:11

HOW TO ANOINT with oil:

"Machag" in Hebrew means – to rub in with oil.

- First of all, allow the precious guidance of the Holy Spirit in every aspect of the anointing.
- The anointing of a person's hands represents the authority of the Holy Spirit in what a person does with his/her hands.
- The anointing of a person's feet represents his/her walk of faith.
- Anointing of the (fore)head can represent the blessing of God in every area. (Psalm 133)
