ESTHER ANOINTING OIL

Proclamation for the Bridal intercession

As a Priest of God, I declare that this oil in my hand is separated unto God, for His purposes alone!

WHAT DOES ESTHER SIGNIFY?

Esther 2:12 – Esther was prepared with myrrh, sweet spices and perfumes during her year of beauty treatment for her purifying before she came to the King. Some of these spices were Cassia, Cedar, Spikenard and Frankincense – all of which are blended in this Esther anointing oil.

PRAY THESE PROCLAMATIONS AS YOU ANOINT WITH ESTHER OIL:

- Lord, I declare that I am favored by You! Esther 7:3
- I accept, declare and proclaim that I have come to have royal position before You for a time such as this! Esther 4:14
- I am anointed and appointed to rule with You in authority and victory! Esther 2:17a
- Lord, because You love me, I have grace in Your sight! Esther 2:17b

HOW TO ANOINT with oil:

"Machag" in Hebrew means – to rub in with oil.

- First of all, allow the precious guidance of the Holy Spirit in every aspect of the anointing.
- The anointing of a person's hands represents the authority of the Holy Spirit in what a person does with his/her hands.
- The anointing of a person's feet represents his/her walk of faith.
- Anointing of the (fore)head can represent the blessing of God in every area. (Psalm 133)
