WHAT DOES OIL OF JOY SIGNIFY?

According to David in Psalm 45:7, 8 Jesus is anointed with the Oil of Joy because He hated wickedness and loved righteousness. David also revealed to us Jesus' fragrance in Ps 45:8, saying that His garments are MYRRH, ALOES, and CASSIA! The very blend of the Oil of Joy! Now He gives us the oil of JOY instead of mourning. (Isa 61:3)

PRAY THESE PROCLAMATIONS AS YOU ANOINT WITH PRAYER WARRIOR OIL:

- I proclaim Lord, that it is not MY joy, but YOUR JOY that will be my strength. Neh 8:10
- I will ever sing and shout for JOY because You make a covering over me and defend me! Ps 5:12
- I declare that You are the restorer of my JOY in Your salvation and You uphold me with a willing spirit! Ps 51:12
- I shall go out with JOY and will be led with peace! Isa 55: 11

HOW TO ANOINT with oil:

"Machag" in Hebrew means – to rub in with oil.

- First of all, allow the precious guidance of the Holy Spirit in every aspect of the anointing.
- The anointing of a person's hands represents the authority of the Holy Spirit in what a person does with his/her hands.
- The anointing of a person's feet represents his/her walk of faith.
- Anointing of the (fore)head can represent the blessing of God in every area. (Psalm 133)
