PURE NARD ANOINTING OIL

Proclaiming EXTRAVAGANT WORSHIP

As a Priest of God, I declare that this oil in my hand is separated unto God, for His purposes alone!

WHAT DOES PURE NARD SIGNIFY?

Pure nard, also known as spikenard signifies extravagant worship! An expensive and rare perfume – bringing healing through its costly fragrance. Mary anointed the feet of Jesus, emptying the total content of her alabaster jar in an act of total surrender and worship. (John 12:3)

PRAY THESE PROCLAMATIONS AS YOU ANOINT WITH PURE NARD OIL:

- I proclaim, Lord, that I will worship You with the heart of Mary, pouring out her ointment of pure liquid Nard on Your feet! Let the whole house be filled with the fragrance of the perfume! Joh 12:3
- Lord, I will enter Your house through the abundance of Your steadfast love. I will worship at Your holy temple in awe of You! Psalms 5:7
- Lord, we have received a Kingdom that cannot be shaken, therefore we offer to You our acceptable worship! Heb 12:28

HOW TO ANOINT with oil:

"Machag" in Hebrew means – to rub in with oil.

- First of all, allow the precious guidance of the Holy Spirit in every aspect of the anointing.
- The anointing of a person's hands represents the authority of the Holy Spirit in what a person does with his/her hands.
- The anointing of a person's feet represents his/her walk of faith.
- Anointing of the (fore)head can represent the blessing of God in every area. (Psalm 133)
